The parking lot opens at 8:00, please exit the event by 4:00PM, thanks....

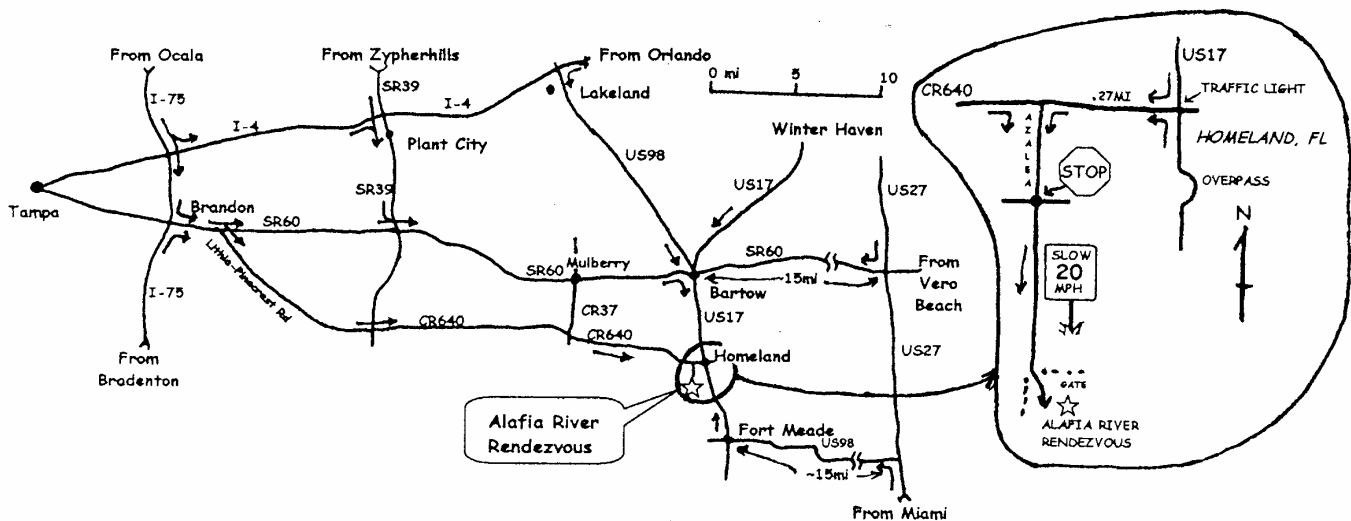
Adults \$10, Seniors (age 60 +) & Children (age 4-15) \$5, under 3 admitted free
